

What to do if you're injured at work

Worker:

- See a health care professional if you need medical care
- Report the injury promptly to your employer
- Use the Worker's Initial Report of Injury (W1) to report the injury

Employer:

- Employers must report to the WCB within five days of learning about the injury
- Use the Employer's Initial Report of Injury (E1) to report the injury
