We like to think we're invincible. The truth is young workers are injured in the workplace every day. Over 6,000 Saskatchewan workers between the ages of 15 and 24 are hurt on the job every year. On average, another two die in a workplace accident annually. The one common thing about all of these injuries and deaths is that they are preventable.

Thinking about safety first can drastically reduce these statistics. Do you and your friends have a story to share or an idea about an *"If it feels wrong, just ask"* moment? Do you know someone who is doing it right around injury prevention?

Now is your chance to get creative and *make a video*. Share your thoughts on workplace health and safety, and injury prevention.

First prize is \$1,000! If your video is one of the top 3 selected, your team and your school will each receive a cash prize. Winning videos will go on to the national contest for a chance at winning even more money.
