



WorkSafe Saskatchewan Youth Video Contest Frequently asked questions

Q. You say this is a contest for students in Grades 9 to 12. Can anybody else enter?

A. No, it is exclusively for Saskatchewan students in Grades 9 to 12.

Q. Will you consider our entry for an award if it comes in after March 27, 2026 at 4 p.m.?

A. No. We must receive your entry by 4 p.m. Central Standard Time on March 27, 2026.

Q. Can I submit a physical video?

A. No. We require you to submit your video entry to us electronically. Include a hyperlink to your video. You can upload it to YouTube (make sure we can download it) or share it with us using Dropbox or Google Drive.

Q. How will you contact the winners?

A. We will notify your teacher, who will let you know that your submission is a winner. You will receive your prize at an awards ceremony scheduled in May or June.

Q. What if our video is a few seconds over the two-minute limit? Will you still accept the video?

A. No. We will disqualify the video, even if it is only a few seconds over the two-minute limit. Even credits must be within the two-minute limit.

Q. Is there a limit to the number of students on my team?

A. No. There is no limit, provided you list each student on your team submission and they each complete and sign an entry form. We will divide prizes among the students of the winning teams.
